



Toulouse Mentoring Programme

Since 2017, we propose to a group of PhD students (with a preference for female students) from the SEVAB, BSB and GEET PhD schools, ideally in their first year of doctoral training, to participate in the mentoring programme, as part of the PhD programme of the Centre for Integrative Biology (CBI, Toulouse). This programme, led by Julie Batut (CNRS Researcher - CBI PhD Programme - Member of Femmes & Sciences) aims to **support doctoral students and encourage them to build their career plans by reflecting on the possibilities and choices open to them with the help of experienced and trusted mentors.** This scheme enables a pair of mentor/doctoral volunteers with no hierarchical link to become part of a **process of mutual enrichment** and to share their knowledge, experience, support and encouragement



The proposed 27-hour module aims to contribute to the success of the doctoral student's project by offering them

- **1.** regular individual exchanges with their mentor
- **2.** thematic discussion circles and group training workshops to answer their needs and questions, such as preparing their thesis committee, presenting their research project, looking for a post-doc, applying for a L'OREAL grant....
- **3.** Seminars and testimonials to present, among other things, various jobs and careers related to scientific research in the academic and private sectors.
